

WEED MULCH_{N6 (01)}

Instructions



Length Ordered: _____ **metres**

Width: approx. 78" / two metres.

Weed mulch is a strong, black polypropylene material, ultra-violet light stabilised to give a 4 - 5 year life.

CREATING A NEW BED

- Dig and prepare the area to be planted.
- Clear as many sharp stones etc. as possible.
- Level the site and lay the Weed Mulch on the top.
- Position your plants and cut cross slits where you wish to plant.

ANCHORING THE WEED MULCH

The Weed Mulch should be held in place by covering with a thin layer of soil or peat - but make sure this is free of weeds!

Alternatively use wood chippings or gravel if preferred.

If no top dressing is required hold down with stones or ground pegs.

EXISTING PLANTED BEDS

- Lay on top of the ground, cutting cross slits where plants are growing.
- Either leave the Weed Mulch uncovered or cover with some form of weed-free top dressing if preferred.
